



Info from the WSPC Annual Meeting

Project Update: Lincoln Park court expansion project is starting in July. The contractor is finishing up the new tennis courts at Canyon View Park and will be moving over to Lincoln Park when those are done. They have an eight week time schedule for the pickleball court project which would put completion in mid to late September depending on how the work flows. A quicker completion is also possible and we will keep everyone informed as we meet monthly with the Parks & Rec staff overseeing the project.

Brick Campaign: We launched a brick campaign at the annual meeting on June 4th. Funds from brick sales will go towards amenities for the courts at Lincoln Park that are not included in the City's budget. Shade structures, benches, tables, wind screens for the fences and hopefully a camera system for viewing court activity on-line. Brick sales are off to a good start with purchase options through an on-line donor site or hard copy order forms available on our website. Anyone can purchase a brick and have it engraved with names, comments, or salutations of your choice. Symbols such as smiley faces, sports logos etc. are available on the larger size bricks(8" & 12").


