Who can be nominated?

Any Club member in good standing, 18 years old *What is the process for Club elections?* (per Club bylaws)

- *All Board Directors serve 3-year staggered terms and may seek re-election
- * via Club member emails:
 - -- **By May 1st -** A list of Board Members seeking re-election and a request for Board Member nominations from the membership
 - --May 15th nominations close

--**after May 15th** - 2nd email to membership with full slate of candidates for members to vote for electronically **until June 1st**.

*Results of the vote are tallied and presented at the annual meeting *At the July Board meeting, Officers are elected and other board positions are filled. Nominees and directors running for re-election are NOT running for a specific board position.

At least 4 Board of Director positions will be available for the upcoming 2023 election. *Please watch for emails and VOTE.* All nominees are welcome. This is your Club and you have a voice.
You are welcome to ask any WSPC Board Director questions regarding duties and responsibilities. Board meetings are held monthly (except December).

USA Pickleball Great Plains Diamond Regional Championship


The event will be at the US Air Force Academy (USAFA) July 7 - 13.

WSPC COMMUNICATION AND POSTING POLICY

<u>Purpose</u> To clarify guidelines for:
 *Member's Corner postings on Club website
 *Emails to membership by Communications Director
 *Facebook page postings

Member's Corner Postings

- Bulletin board style posting page on westernslopepickleballclub.com, website was developed for club members to share announcements, invitations and information for the purpose of sharing with other club members.
 - Proposed items for posting must be in PDF format, dated with the full name, city and phone contact of the posting member. Submit items to Tracy Dvorak,

Club Website Director at tracy.r.dvorak@gmail.com.

- Postings will be reviewed by a Member's Corner moderator for approval before posting on the website.
- Lost and found items (check the court lost and found storage boxes before posting).
 - Items for sale are limited to pickleball related items.
 - No business advertising or political postings.
 - Postings are limited to a maximum of 30 days.

WSPC Facebook Page

•Assigned "administrators" will monitor all postings and reply to questions. They may delete any posting deemed inappropriate. •Postings, including photos, area tournament and clinic dates are open to all Facebook users.

WSPC Email Policy

• The WSPC Communications Director maintains two email lists of pickleball players; one of Club members and a second one of non-Club members.

Both lists are used to provide players with information regarding local pickleball.

• Members are also sent information related to the Club's functions, pickleball related information (such as tournament announcements)

from across the state of Colorado, and information related to illness or death of a member or, when requested, that of an immediate family member.

 The policy seeks to avoid overwhelming recipients with emails. In this regard, it is our policy, with few exceptions, to not send emails related to lost and found items. We also attempt to combine emails in order to reduce the number that are sent.

• The Communications Director will determine what notifications meet the above requirements on a case-by-case basis.

A Quick Pickleball Tip from Brenda Furnace:

This is an easy way to keep track of the score. The first player always starts serving from the right corner of their side. So the player who begins the game will always have an even score when they are on the right side.

Referee Info

Congratulations to Eileen Egloff!

Eileen passed her evaluations to become a Level 3 Referee. Level 3 Refs can go and teach independently and also get paid more for refereeing matches.

Eileen holds referee training clinics here in GJ to train interested people how to be a pickleball referee. If you'd like to know more about these Referee Training Clinics, read on...

In the last week of March, two referee training clinics were conducted by our registered USA Pickleball referee training instructor, Eileen Egloff, in the Lincoln Park Barn with a total of 18 enthusiastic attendees. Included in the attendess were experienced Level 2 refs, Level 1 refs who will be working on their Level 2, and new students interested in becoming pickleball referees. WSPC provided pizza on both days as they continued with class instruction through lunchtime.

Referees are a very important part of tournaments. They keep the games running smoothly, on time, and keep much of the controversy, stress and line call arguments from occurring. They also make sure the correct rules are applied in the game. Most players are very appreciative of officiating. Learning the process can be very confusing and there is a lot of effort and time involved to learn to officiate pickleball correctly. The attendees spent from 9a-3p in classroom instruction and hands-on practice. You may see many of them in the days ahead prior to and during the club tournament. Please welcome these new referees when they ask if they can practice officiating your recreational match and know they have donated a lot of time to get to where they are in the officiating process.




