

WSPC ACCOMPLISHMENTS JUNE 2016 - MAY 31, 2017

- ✓ Four west courts at Lincoln Park (LP) converted to dual use Pickleball and Tennis courts. Court modifications implemented – done by GJ Parks & Rec with WSPC input – July 2016
- ✓ Provided free pickleball drilling lessons as part of first year membership. Lessons donated by Tao Thongvanh, GJ Pickleball Ambassador.
- ✓ Provided WSPC T-Shirts to all members
- ✓ WSPC Website and Facebook Page created – Sept. 2016
- ✓ Storage boxes purchased and installed at east LP and Pineridge (PR) courts to hold balls, lost & found items, first aid kit, score sheets for referee practice – Sept. 2016 (Storage box for west LP courts to follow when available for purchase).
- ✓ Balls provided at LP and PR courts – Sept. 2016 ongoing supply for all players
- ✓ Squeegees - new squeegees purchased by Parks & Rec for LP and PR courts – Sept./Oct. 2016
- ✓ Added blackout curtains to some Lincoln Park Barn windows as a test – Oct. 2016. Planning to provide curtains for the remaining windows next indoor season.
- ✓ Nets - 1 net purchased and installed at the Barn/PR outdoor nets repaired by Parks & Rec – Nov. 2016; 4 new nets installed at Pineridge by Parks & Rec – April 2017
- ✓ AED for each court – Automated External Defibrillator signage at LP for unit access at the golf clubhouse – signage provided by GJ Parks & Rec – Nov. 2016

- ✓ Applied for official organizational nonprofit 501(c)7 status – Club bylaws finalized & registration submitted – Jan. 2017
- ✓ Provided referee and/or tournament volunteer training for about 30 people – March & April 2017
- ✓ First Aid kits provided to court storage boxes – March 2017
- ✓ Held First Annual WSPC Championship Tournament for members - April 2017 (70 members participated)
- ✓ Held a members dinner after the WSPC tournament hosted by member Greg Reicks. April 2017
- ✓ Working in concert with GJ Parks & Rec to resurface and possibly reconfigure PR courts – currently ongoing
