

## WSPC ACCOMPLISHMENTS – JUNE 1, 2017-MAY 31, 2018:

- ✓ Pineridge Courts Resurfaced and Expanded – Aug-Sept. 2017 - Original GJ Parks & Rec. project budgeted for court resurfacing and keeping current two tennis courts with lines for four non-permanent pickleball courts.

With input from the Club and Tao Thongvanh, and over \$2,000 collected from Sweet 16 fundraisers, the project was changed to reduce the number of tennis courts from two to one while increasing the number of pickleball courts from four to six. The new configuration is as follows: two dedicated pickleball courts with permanent nets + 2 dedicated pickleball courts with portable nets + 2 pickleball courts with portable nets within one tennis court.

- ✓ Community Service (June 2016-May 31, 2018) – 36 Club volunteers logged a total of **307** hours. Various efforts include: Family Pickleball Clinic, in conjunction with GJ Parks & Rec, Adopt a Road Clean-up (24 Rd), New Dimension Pickleball Classes, P.L.A.C.E. participation in support of the GJ Community Recreation Center; and garage sale to benefit Houston hurricane victims.

Beginner & Intermediate Pickleball Clinics: Club volunteers, in conjunction with GJ Parks & Rec have offered these programs to 180 participants over the last 12 months. Dedication by George Gerson (24 hours) and Club volunteers (60 hours) has been key to growing the sport of Pickleball and Club membership.

- ✓ Family Pickleball Clinic – Sept. 2017 in conjunction with GJ Parks & Rec.
- ✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Club Championship Tournament – **86** participants April 2018.
- ✓ 1<sup>st</sup> Club Singles Tournament – **27** participants April 2018.
