While the Club exists thanks to the support of its members, our aim is to grow the sport for the benefit of the entire pickleball community. Here are some examples:

How the WSPC Benefits all Players

- The WSPC works with Parks & Rec to increase and improve pickleball facilities
- A substantial portion of dues collected from members is being saved for the purpose of helping to fund the construction of new courts
- Club volunteers are the instructors for Group Clinics arranged by Parks and Rec for adults and children. We also have members who provide private lessons.
- The Club sponsors and facilitates round robins at Pineridge and Lincoln Park and provides balls and equipment for the round robins
- The Club has represented the pickleball community in City events such as the Community Streets event, the Grand Junction Christmas Parade, and the Fruita Christmas Parade.
- It Conducts an annual Food Drive and Toys for Tots Drive in Grand Junction, Fruita, and Palisade.
- The Club buys pickleballs in bulk and resells them to players at cost
- It provides local updates by e-mail to all players
- It has Board Members who act as liaisons to the courts at Lincoln Park, Pineridge, Fruita and Palisade to help resolve any issues that arise at each location.
- It provides a Website for information on local pickleball
- It helps non-profit organizations hold fund raising pickleball tournaments
- It trains referees who volunteer for both Club and City tournaments
- The Club has adopted a stretch of 24 Rd which is kept clean by Club volunteers
